When and where is the Greater Waterbury March for Babies?

Sunday May 6th, 2018- Rain or Shine at Quassy Amusement Park Route 64, 2132 Middlebury Road, Middlebury, CT 06762

- o Registration opens at 10am
- o Superhero Sprint 10:40am \$20 (\$10 for each additional sibling) Includes a cape!
- o Opening Ceremony to follow Superhero Sprint
- o Walk begins at 11am

Is parking available?

Yes, there is plenty of free parking at Quassy. We hope that you will stay after the walk to enjoy the park, and please take advantage of the discounted ride coupon that they will be passing out that morning! You can buy a wristband for \$13.99 (Regular price \$21.00).

Where do I go once I arrive?

Head down to the Pavilion/Field. Registration check-in is located under the Pavilion. Volunteer and Superhero Sprint check-ins are located outside of the pavilion. Look for March of Dimes volunteers in orange VOLUNTEER or STAFF shirts if you need assistance.

What should I do with donations I have collected?

Thank you for your support of the health of moms and babies! To ensure appropriate credit and recognition:

- Please print & complete a Participant Donation Form & bring it to the event (see attached).
- o If you're a Team Captain, make sure your team members print & submit theirs too.

How long is the walk?

The walk is approximately 3 miles.

Can I bring my dog?

Dogs are welcome but must be leashed. Please be courteous and clean up any messy business.

"HOPE, REMEMBER, CELEBRATE" at the walk!



"HOPE"- Visit with staff from Saint Mary's Hospital, receive a lei in honor or memory of your baby, & sign our "Why I Walk" banner.



"REMEMBER"- Visit the butterfly garden and write a message on a butterfly or onesie in honor of an angel baby.



"CELEBRATE"- Superhero Sprint! Music! Face painting! Touch a Truck! Selfie Station! Bounce house! An adult must sign the waiver before kids can bounce. Please don't leave your child unattended.

Will there be food and drinks?

- Water, coffee, fruit, and snacks are complimentary
- Quassy will be selling food at their grill under the pavilion with a portion of proceeds benefitting March of Dimes.

Where are the restrooms?

Portable restrooms are located next to the Pavilion and along the walk route.
