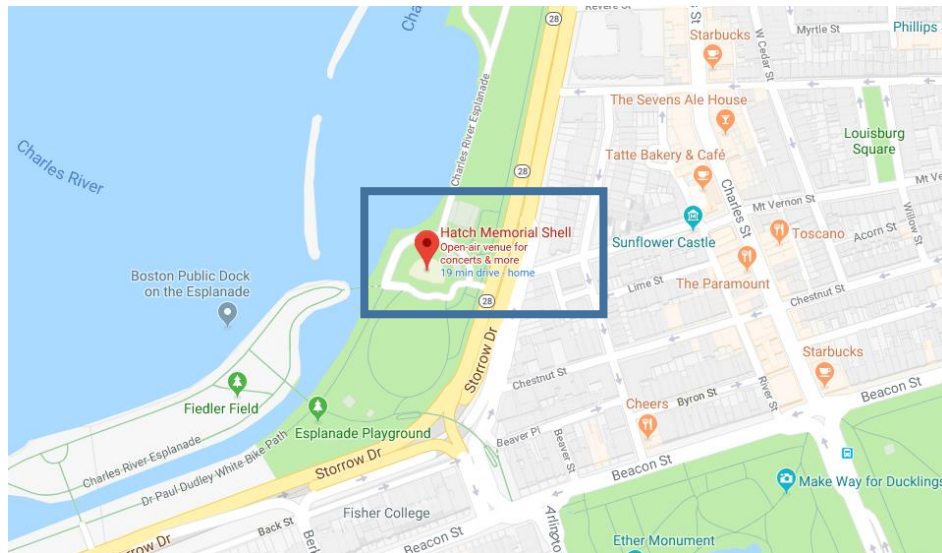




We are back at the Hatch Shell this year!

The walk is at the Hatch Memorial Shell, 45 David G. Mugar Way, Boston. You can search the location using Google Maps or any other map app for directions.

The Hatch Shell is accessible via car and subway.



Closest Parking Garages:

The closest and most convenient parking is at the **Boston Common Garage**. It is **\$10 on weekends to park for up to an hour, \$14 for 1-3 hours, and \$18 for over three hours**. Directions can be found on their website at <http://massconvention.com/about-us/boston-common-garage>.

Please note, parking in this garage can fill up fast, especially on a nice day. To get from the garage to the DCR Hatch Shell, walk north on Charles Street towards Beacon Hill, take a left on Beacon Street, take a right onto David Mugar Way and cross the footbridge. It can take about 15 minutes to walk from the Common Garage to the DCR Hatch Shell. Parking in Boston is tight so plan ahead and arrive with plenty of time to park and get to the DCR Hatch Shell. Alternative parking garage is the Charles Street Parking Garage.

You will **NOT be able to park on Storrow Drive**. You will be allowed to drop off on Storrow Drive in front of the DCR Hatch Shell between 8:30am and 9:30am, but a driver has to stay with the vehicle at all times.

Closest MBTA Stops:

The Charles/MGH Stop on the red line is the closest T stop. To get from the T stop to the DCR Hatch Shell, head south on Charles Street towards Massachusetts 3AS, continue onto Cambridge Street, take a left onto Charles Street, sharp right on to Silver Place, cross the footbridge and take the path to the DCR Hatch Shell.

The Arlington Stop on the green line is another option. To get from the T stop to the DCR Hatch Shell, head east on Boylston Street, turn left onto Arlington Street, sharp left onto Beacon Street, cross the footbridge and take the path to the DCR Hatch Shell.
