



March for Babies - Kitsap

FAQ

Q. Where is March for Babies Kitsap held?

A. March for Babies will be held at Haselwood Family YMCA located at 3909 NW Randall Way, Silverdale, 98383.

Q. How long is the walk route?

A. The walk route length is about 3.5 miles. If you feel this might be a challenging distance for you, there will be a "Victory Van" available to pick up walkers and drive them back to the YMCA. Checkpoint volunteers will be able to reach the Victory Van by phone.

Q. Are strollers allowed?

A. Yes, strollers, wagons, and wheelchairs are allowed. Roller skates, bicycles, and skateboards are not allowed due to safety concerns.

Q. Will there be restrooms along the walk route?

A. Yes, portable toilets will be available for use along the walk route.

Q. Are pets allowed?

A. Yes, as long as they are kept on a leash at all times. Please also come prepared with proper waste disposal baggies for clean-up.

Q. Can I turn my donations in at the walk?

A. YES! Donations are accepted at the Registration tent beginning at 8:00 AM. If you are a team captain, please come prepared with your envelope printed with the name of each fundraising walker's fund designation to ensure proper account crediting.

Q. Is there a "registration fee"?

A. We do not have a registration fee but ask that all participants commit to raising funds for the March of Dimes. March of Dimes staff is available to help support you in your fundraising efforts.

Q. What do I need to do to form a team?

A. All that is needed to form a team for March for Babies is the ability to ask your friends, family, and co-workers to join you and your choice of a team name!

Q. What do I wear?

A. We've ordered a sunny day for March for Babies, but just in case, be prepared for cold or rainy weather. March for Babies will take place rain or shine. Remember, mornings can be chilly in Silverdale. We recommend bringing umbrellas, gloves, hats and sunglasses.

Q. Can I walk as an individual if I do not want to form a team?

A. You are more than welcome to walk as an individual and we invite you to join our Circle of Champions that fundraise \$1,000 or more on an individual basis.

Q. Will there be food at the walk?

A. Yes, we will have snack items such as granola bars, fruit, breakfast pastries, coffee, and water free of charge before the walk, first come, first served.

Q. Will there be activities for children at the walk?

A. Yes, we will have face painting, lawn games, and bouncy houses for the children both before and after the walk.

Q. Where do I park?

A. The YMCA will designate a portion of their parking lot for March for Babies participants until they reach capacity (~100 cars.) When you arrive, please follow the directions of our parking attendant volunteers to this area or to overflow lots. The Regal Cinemas (9923 Poplars Avenue Northwest), AMC 8 (10055 Kitsap Mall Boulevard Northwest), and C-Stock (9729 Silverdale Way Northwest) all have parking lots available that morning for the use of our walkers.

Q. Can I collect donations after the walk?

A. Yes, donations count towards your March for Babies fundraising until December 31, 2015. You can mail donations to our office located at 2102 N Pearl St, Ste. 401, Tacoma, WA 98406.
