

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the registration fee for the walk?

There is no 'registration fee' for the walk. However, March for Babies is a fundraiser - we encourage you to register at marchforbabies.org and donate to yourself to kick start your fundraising. Money raised through March for Babies goes to research and community programs to help moms have full-term pregnancies and healthy babies. Where do I park?

With more than 3,000 walkers attending the event, please allow yourself ample time to arrive, find parking around Reid Park and walk to the start/finish area. Consider carpooling.

Do I need to check-in or register after I arrive?

You do not have to check-in once you arrive at the walk. We encourage you to register before the walk at marchforbabies.org. If you would like to make a donation or turn in your fundraising dollars, you may do so at the Registration Tent.

Where is the start/finish line?

The location of the picnic area, stage, start/finish and route will begin at the Reid Park DeMeester Outdoor Performance Center a.k.a. The Bandshell.

Will March for Babies take place if there is bad weather?

March for Babies will take place unless the City of Tucson or Tucson Police Department determines the weather is too hazardous for the walkers to be at the site or on the route.

What is the March for Babies route?

The Tucson March for Babies is a three-mile walk. Individuals may run the route if they wish to do so. Rest stops are provided along the route with water. Route maps will be available for download mid April at marchforbabies.org/event/tucson.

Will there be any first aid available?

Yes, we have paramedics on site.

Are pets and bikes allowed at the event?

For the safety of all participants, please NO pets. Service animals are welcome. Please, no bicycles, scooters, skateboards, roller skates or roller blades. Strollers and wagons are welcome.
