## FAQs for March for Babies 2015 at Quassy



### Parking

There is plenty of free parking at Quassy Amusement Park. If you are staying after the walk to enjoy the park, why not take advantage of their online [CARLOAD SPECIAL](#)? Just use promo code BABIES and \$5 of each one purchased online for Sunday will be donated to the March of Dimes. PLEASE NOTE: This special will not be available on walk day.

### Where Do I Go Once I Arrive?

Follow the REGISTRATION signs down to the Pavilion/Field. Look for March of Dimes volunteers in white VOLUNTEER shirts if you need assistance.

### Can I bring my dog?

Yes, dogs are allowed, as long as they are leashed. We will have treats & water dishes available for our 4-legged friends who are using their paws to support the cause.

### What happens if it rains?

The babies need us no matter what! March for Babies takes place rain or shine. No rain date.

### Do I need to register on walk day? Yes!

If you have registered online before walk day, you still need to check in at REGISTRATION and hand in a copy of your Sponsor Form (print this out by logging in to your personal page on [marchforbabies.org](http://marchforbabies.org)). This is also where you will turn in any outstanding cash/check donations.

If you have NOT registered online, you can register on-site from 10-11 am before the walk. Or register online now at [marchforbabies.org](http://marchforbabies.org) and follow the instructions above.

**For Team Members:** Collect all cash & checks and put in an envelope with Your Name, Team Name and total \$ amount enclosed clearly marked.

**Team TIP:** Meet as a team and give everything to Team Captain. Then he/she can come to registration area. It is a good idea to set up a meeting place for the morning of the walk (for example: near the Bounce House or by the balloon arch).

### Do I get a T-shirt?

Our March for Babies incentive t-shirt is given to walkers who **raise \$200 or more**. Please remember this is an ***individual*** incentive and not a team incentive. While supplies last—a rain check will be issued in case of a shortage. We do not sell t-shirts the day of the walk.

### Where are the restrooms?

Portable restrooms are located next to the Pavilion and along the walk route.

### What happens during the walk?

The walk is approximately 3 miles and it leaves the park. There will be a diagram on the programs, and the route will be marked with signs. A police officer will assist with traffic crossing over Route 64. There will also be a couple of rest stops along the way where you can get water.

### Pre-Walk Ceremony

The March for Babies stage ceremonies will begin at approximately 10:40 am. The National Anthem will be sung by Tanya Leonard. Ron Dibble from 97.9 ESPN radio/IHeart Media is our emcee, and our Ambassador family – the Lynns – will speak and then cut the start ribbon to officially begin the walk!

### Walk Day Activities/Food

Thanks to our generous donors, there will be complimentary coffee, water, juice, muffins, assorted fruit, cheese sticks, and yogurt for our participants. Quassy staff will be cooking/selling hot dogs/hamburgers/fries under the Pavilion, beginning at 11:30, so please bring cash if you're interested. 10% of the net proceeds of the food sales will be donated to the March of Dimes.

There will be face painting, a bounce house, a live DJ, chair massages, mission/kids activities, free mini bottles of bubbles for the kids and more!
