READING March for Babies

What should I make sure I bring on walk day?

Be sure to bring all your donations and print your donation form or fill out the form we posted online. ONE form per every walker turning in donations. You may also want to bring extra water or sunblock because we are hoping for Sunny Skies on walk day. Remember: The walk is held RAIN or SHINE!

Do I get a t-shirt? Where do I pick up rewards I earned?

Any walker who has fundraised \$100 or more will receive a March for Babies t-shirt. Rewards will be handed out at the REGISTRATION TABLES.

Can we have a Team Photo taken? Where?

The team photo spot will be in front of the Nittany Lion. Gather your group and stop by for a photo. Team photos will be taken until the Opening Ceremonies begins at 10:15am and will resume when you return to the festival site. Don't forget to [#marchforbabies](#) when you post on social media!

How long is the March for Babies route? Can I bring a stroller/wagon?

The family-friendly route is less than 3 miles long throughout the campus. Strollers and wagon are welcome.

We made our own Team T-shirt. Tell me about the t-shirt contest.

Team t-shirts can be brought to the HOPE tent and hung on our clothes line. T-shirts will be judged during the march. You can pick-up your shirt before you leave for the day.

Will food be served?

Hot dogs, pretzels, and water will be available at the Finish Line Festival Site at the end of the walk. Look for fruit and water at the start area and the checkpoint.

What activities will there be?

Music, Memory Garden, Bounce House, and [SUPERHERO SPRINT](#) for children ages 1-10. There is a fee: \$20 for the first child and \$10 for each additional child. Register online on your personal page or on the day of the walk.

Are dogs allowed at the event?

YES! Sign your pooch up at www.marchforbabies.org/team/pawsreading and if they raise at least \$25 they'll get a special March for Babies branded Doggie Waste Bag Holder! Please be sure to clean up after your pup while walking. Dogs that may become upset or aggressive with large crowds may want to forego the event.
