why march in clermont?

In an Average Week in Ohio:

- 2,676 infants are born
- 264 infants are born to teen mothers (ages 15-19)
- 821 infants are delivered by cesarean section
- 327 infants are born preterm
- 229 infants are born with low birth weight
- 22 infants die before their first birthday
- Preventing premature birth in Ohio could mean an annual savings of up to **\$878 Million.**
