What is March of Dimes March for Babies?

As the March of Dimes signature event fundraiser, March for Babies supports the March of Dimes mission to improve the health of babies. More than 7 million people participate as walkers, volunteers and sponsors in more than 900 communities nationwide.

In 2014, more than 200 walkers raised over \$45,000 in the Eastern Panhandle March for Babies.

When is March for Babies?

In **Eastern Panhandle**, March for Babies will be held on **Saturday, April 25, 2015** at **War Memorial Park**. Registration opens at **9:00 a.m.** and the walk starts at **10:00 a.m.**
