Directions

I-4 East bound: Take South Street exit and continue North on Garland to Central Blvd. and make a right. The Library garage is on Central between Magnolia and Rosalind on South/Right side.

I-4 West bound: Take State Road 50 (Colonial) exit and go straight onto Hughey to Central Blvd. and make a left. The Library garage is on Central between Magnolia and Rosalind on South/Right side.

Parking

Parking will be available downtown in metered spots as well as parking garages. Please be sure to pay the meters. Parking in the Library and Administration Garages is available at \$5 per vehicle.


Donations
